## ON THE PALETTE NUMBER OF A GRAPH

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Let G be a finite simple graph, C a set of colours and  $\varphi: E(G) \to C$  a proper edge colouring of G. The palette (or else the colour set) of a vertex  $v \in V(G)$  (with respect to  $\varphi$ ) is the set  $\{\varphi(e): e \ni v\}$  of colours of edges incident with v. The palette number of the graph G is the maximum number of (distinct) palettes in a proper edge colouring of G. An overview of results on the palette number will be presented.
